



## State BEARFACTS 1993 – 2003

### Kansas

The population of Kansas in 2003 was 2,721,824. Its rank was 32nd in the nation.

#### PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Kansas had a per capita personal income (PCPI) of \$29,802. This PCPI ranked 26th in the United States and was 95 percent of the national average, \$31,504. The 2003 PCPI reflected an increase of 2.8 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 2.2 percent. In 1993 the PCPI of Kansas was \$20,234 and ranked 23rd in the United States. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of PCPI was 3.9 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 4.0 percent.

#### TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

In 2003 Kansas had a total personal income (TPI) of \$81,116,278\*. This TPI ranked 31st in the United States. In 1993 the TPI of Kansas was \$51,729,299\* and ranked 31st in the United States. The 2003 TPI reflected an increase of 3.2 percent from 2002. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.1 percent. The 1993-2003 average annual growth rate of TPI was 4.6 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.1 percent.

#### COMPONENTS OF TOTAL PERSONAL INCOME

Total personal income includes net earnings by place of residence; dividends, interest, and rent; and total personal current transfer receipts received by the residents of Kansas. In 2003 net earnings accounted for 69.3 percent of TPI (compared with 67.6 in 1993); dividends, interest, and rent were 16.2 percent (compared with 18.7 in 1993); and personal current transfer receipts were 14.5 percent (compared with 13.7 in 1993). From 2002 to 2003 net earnings increased 5.0 percent; dividends, interest, and rent decreased 5.0 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased 4.9 percent. From 1993 to 2003 net earnings increased on average 4.9 percent each year; dividends, interest, and rent increased on average 3.1 percent; and personal current transfer receipts increased on average 5.2 percent.

#### EARNINGS BY PLACE OF WORK

Earnings of persons employed in Kansas increased from \$59,209,185\* in 2002 to \$62,149,802\* in 2003, an increase of 5.0 percent. The 2002-2003 national change was 3.8 percent. The average annual growth rate from the 1993 estimate of \$38,314,524\* to the 2003 estimate was 5.0 percent. The average annual growth rate for the nation was 5.3 percent.

*\*Note: All income estimates with the exception of PCPI are in thousands of dollars, not adjusted for inflation.*
