


## Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2016

Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services Led Growth in the Plains Region

- Real GDP expanded in 22 of the 28 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from -4.1 percent to 5.3 percent in 2016, with the fastest growth occurring in St. Cloud, MN and Mankato-North Mankato, MN.
- Professional, scientific, and technical services contributed the most to growth in real GDP for the region. This region accounts for 4.9 percent of the nation's current-dollar GDP in professional, scientific, and technical services.
- Kansas City, MO-KS—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 31<sup>st</sup> largest in the nation—experienced growth of 1.0 percent due to growth in finance and insurance. Omaha-Council Bluffs, NE-IA—the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 52<sup>nd</sup> largest in the nation—experienced growth of 1.1 percent due to growth in finance and insurance.
