


Gross Domestic Product (GDP) by Metropolitan Area, 2016

Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services Led Growth in the Southeast Region

- Real GDP expanded in 73 of the 114 MSAs wholly contained in this region. Growth in real GDP ranged from –11.5 percent to 8.1 percent in 2016, with the fastest growth occurring in Lake Charles, LA and Brunswick, GA.
- Professional, scientific, and technical services contributed the most to growth in real GDP for the region. This region accounts for 19.7 percent of the nation's current-dollar GDP in professional, scientific, and technical services.
- Atlanta-Sandy Springs-Roswell, GA—the largest metropolitan area in the region, and 10th largest in the nation—experienced growth of 3.7 percent due to growth in information services. Miami-Fort Lauderdale-West Palm Beach, FL—the 2nd largest metropolitan area in the region, and the 12th largest in the nation—experienced growth of 2.6 percent due to growth in information services.
