Imports

* June real dollar imports of petroleum (\$10.9 billion) were the lowest since April 2020 (\$10.2 billion).

Country and Other Highlights (Census Basis, not seasonally adjusted)

Balance

* The June deficit with Mexico (\$21.3 billion) was the highest on record.

* The June deficit with Vietnam (\$23.6 billion) was the highest on record.

* The June deficit with South Korea (\$8.4 billion) was the highest on record.

Exports

* June exports to Thailand (\$2.5 billion) were the highest on record.

Imports

* June imports from Mexico (\$55.3 billion) were the highest on record.

* June imports from Vietnam (\$25.2 billion) were the highest on record.

* June imports from South Korea (\$15.4 billion) were the highest on record.

* June imports from South and Central America (\$15.6 billion) were the highest since March 2012 (\$16.6 billion).
