


SPENDING ON ARTS AND CULTURAL PRODUCTION CONTINUES TO INCREASE

Nominal value added from all arts and cultural production (ACP) industries— a measure of this sector's contribution to gross domestic product (GDP)—increased 3.8 percent, or \$25.8 billion in 2012, according to new statistics released by the Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA). Value added for ACP accounted for 4.3 percent, or \$698.7 billion, of GDP.


"With the creation of new data analyses like this one – which shows how arts and culture contribute to GDP – the Department of Commerce is providing a more detailed picture of what drives the U.S. economy, growth, and job creation," said Secretary of Commerce Penny Pritzker. "Making new data available is another example of how the government is working harder and smarter to produce relevant statistics that better inform individuals, businesses, and decision-makers."



ACPSA Output. Output for all ACPSA commodities was \$1.1 trillion in 2012. The core ACPSA commodities contributed \$571.1 billion and the supporting ACPSA commodities contributed \$561.2 billion. The primary contributor to the core ACPSA output was advertising with an output of \$239.8 billion; the primary contributor to the supporting ACPSA output was broadcasting with an output of \$118.4 billion.



ACPSA Employment. Employment for all ACPSA industries was 4.7 million jobs in 2012. The core ACPSA industries contributed one million jobs, while the supporting ACPSA industries contributed 3.5 million jobs. The advertising industry was the primary contributor to the core ACPSA employment, with 133.5 thousand jobs. The primary contributor to supporting ACPSA industries was the government sector, with 1.1 million jobs.



Definitions

ACPSA output. ACPSA output consists of all domestically produced goods and services purchased (for example, movie tickets or design services).

ACPSA employment. ACPSA employment consists of all jobs where the workers are engaged in the production of ACPSA output (for example, dancers or architects).

These statistics are from BEA's Art and Cultural Production Satellite Account (ACPSA), which are supported by funding from the National Endowment for the Arts (NEA).

This release of the ACPSA incorporates estimates from the comprehensive revision (CR) of the Industry Economic Accounts¹. The CR introduced improvements which are outside the scope of an annual revision. These improvements include:

- Updated industry and commodity definitions consistent with the 2007 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS).
- The capitalization of entertainment, literary, and other artistic originals.
- Incorporation of newly available and revised annual source data.

Defining 'Culture' in the context of Input-Output Tables for the Arts and Cultural Production Satellite Account

Culture can be defined in a variety of ways to include: language, traditions, beliefs and values. For this account, we defined arts and cultural production narrowly to include creative artistic activity; the goods and services produced by it; the goods and services produced in the support of it; and finally the construction of buildings in which it is taking place.

The Input-Output (I-O) table is a valuable tool to identify and then estimate the value of the 'creative chain.' This chain captures the economic value as we move from the creation of a cultural product (composing a symphony) to its production (the performance being recorded in a studio), then the distribution (by various modes), and finally the consumption (by the listener).
